

RCA use fields belonging to RRUFC. Lost arrows left on the rugby pitches create a high risk of severe personal injury to rugby players.

All arrows must be taken home; you must **never** leave arrows on the field. If we fail to get this right, the Rugby Club can stop us shooting outdoors. As a guide:

1. Put 7 arrows in your quiver.
2. Watch every arrow so you know where they land.
3. After scoring, count your arrows to make sure you always have 7.
4. Finally, before you go back to the range, count your arrows again.



If an arrow is lost, take time to search for the missing arrow before continuing with the next end. If a visual search does not reveal the lost arrow, use the metal detector which can be found in the container.

If after exhaustive searching an arrow cannot be found, you must fill in a Lost Arrow Report which can be found in the indoor range and on the club website. You must inform the Equipment Officer or Secretary.
