RCA is a target archery club affiliated to Archery GB.

We are a *not-for-profit* club run by volunteer members.

Recurve, compound, barebow, longbow and Adriatic bows are welcome.  
Crossbow is not permitted.

We have coaches qualified to Session Coach (L1) and Development Coach (L2).

The club aims to be inclusive for all ages, abilities, and genders. Safeguarding of all participants is important to us especially for children and young people.

We have strong safeguarding policies - see club Admin noticeboard.

## WebCollect

To join RCA, you must place an order on WebCollect:

1. [webcollect.org.uk/rca](http://webcollect.org.uk/rca)
2. Set up an account in your name (unless you have already done so).
3. Browse Subscriptions to find your category of Membership - Senior, Junior, or Disabled.
4. Add to Basket.
5. Select payment type - Bank Transfer is preferred by the Treasurer.
6. Pay your member fees - please quote the bank reference given by WebCollect.

## Membership Fees

You cannot shoot in the range unless you have paid your membership fees.

RCA membership fees include affiliation to Archery GB (AGB), Northern Counties Archery Society (NCAS) and Lancashire Archery Association (LAA). The affiliation fees are fixed must be paid upfront.

The fees to RCA are based on the month you join.

## Induction

After joining as a member you will need Induction - a guide to the range and club rules.

There is a small refundable deposit for your key and fob.

Seniors £10 - key and fob.

Juniors £5 - fob only (no key).

Book your Induction on WebCollect - [webcollect.org.uk/rca](http://webcollect.org.uk/rca) - in the same way you ordered your membership.

## New Members

New members are encouraged to buy their personal accessories, e.g., finger sling, finger tab, arm guard, chest guard, quiver, bow stand, arrow puller.

Please do not buy your own bow or arrows too soon, they will quickly become unsuitable and will need to be replaced.

Use club equipment for a small voluntary contribution of £1 per session.

When you are ready for your own bow our coaches will gladly help you.

## Indoor Range

Members of RCA can use the indoor range 24/7, except Friday nights.

Junior archers must be accompanied by a responsible adult and can only shoot in the range if there is a senior archer present.

Friends/family can come to the range as spectators but cannot shoot.

## Development

Coaching for new archers who have completed the Beginners Course are on Mondays and Tuesdays, except 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday of each month when there is a Committee Meeting.

## Friday Juniors

We have a dedicated club night for our juniors (8-25) every Friday night 6:30-9:00pm.

During the Friday night session, the range is closed to senior archers, unless you want to help.

The session will always have at least one coach present, usually two or three.

All coaches are DBS checked.

Our junior archers also get extra coaching with Lancs Junior Squad.
